

Purpose-Centered SEL Grant Application SY27-28

GRANT APPLICATION GUIDELINES and EXPECTATIONS

Purpose	Wayfinder was founded at Stanford University in 2015 with the aim of equipping educators with the tools to help students live healthy lives of meaning and purpose. At Wayfinder, our theory of change is: If educators help students find meaning and purpose, then those students will have a better relationship with themselves and their community and be equipped to make a positive contribution in the world. Wayfinder partners with thousands of schools across the county, bringing purpose-centered SEL to over 1 million students through our: 1) Comprehensive, culturally relevant, and research backed SEL curricula; 2) Best-in-class formative and summative assessment tool called Waypoints; and 3) Comprehensive teacher training and ongoing school support.
Award:	Wayfinder is partnering with The Education Foundation of Baltimore County Public Schools to continue to offer our comprehensive SEL solution to 19 of the existing partnering schools and up to 19 new schools for school year 2027-2028. <i>*This grant is contingent on The Foundation securing a CRRF Grant from the Baltimore County Government.</i>
Key Criteria & Eligible Projects:	Review and award will be based on a school's ability and demonstrated commitment to implementing Wayfinder with fidelity during the 2027-2028 school year. Participating schools are committing to: • Send at least one (1), but no more than five (5) staff members to an initial face-to-face training on May 27, 2027 from 12:00-2:30 pm at the Exchange in Windsor Mill (2034 F Lord Baltimore Drive, Windsor Mill, MD 21244). • Schedule time for a one-hour virtual kick-off training in August 2027 with all participating educators. • Commit to 90 minutes in the Fall of 2027 for an in-person training to be scheduled in consultation with awarded buildings' leaders. • Commit to implementing the program with fidelity for two school years (2027-2028 & 2028-2029)

Application Deadline:	<u>DEADLINE Friday, October 30, 2026 at or before 5:00 p.m.</u>
Notification of Recipients:	Schools selected to move forward in The Foundation's CRRF grant application will receive an e-mail notification from the foundation's Associate Director, Dr. Heather Wooldridge on or before November 16, 2026. A media release/Mission Moment blog post and announcement on The Education Foundation of Baltimore County Public Schools website and all social media outlets will be released once the grant has been secured.
Awarding of Materials:	All participating educators will receive digital access to Wayfinder's online curricula by August 13, 2027. <i>*This date is subject to change.</i>

Proposal Review:	Proposals will be competitively reviewed by the Programs and Allocations Committee of The Education Foundation of BCPS, Inc. and staff from Wayfinder. BCPS curriculum and instruction and/or business services professionals may be consulted as part of the proposal review for the purpose of compliance and alignment. All applications will be scored by three experts in the field.
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Initiative Summary:	A final project summary and storyboard with photos and grant highlights must be submitted to The Education Foundation of BCPS, Inc. upon the initiative's conclusion no later than May 26, 2028. (A Purpose-Centered SEL storyboard template will be sent electronically to the grant recipient in the congratulatory e-mail notification). A grant recipient who does not submit a summary and storyboard <u>will not</u> be eligible for future funding consideration until both have been received.
